## Meeting Notes...

### EVENTS

- **Mike Kaczowski – BeaverRun Event**

ACNA-WPC will have the opportunity to participate in a track event to be held at BeaverRun. We will do this in conjunction with another club or on an open track day, probably in August.

In order to organize the activity and set the date Mark will need to know how many club members are interested in participating. The number of responses received will dictate the event's format. We must select the type of event; **Flat-out Day** or **Autocross**.

A **Flat-out Day** consists of class room training followed by non-competitive on-track driving (however, each driver shares the track with several other drivers). An instructor will ride with you as you drive your vehicle on the course. Each driver will get multiple 10 minute runs. This is typically a weekend event (Saturday or Sunday). Cost for this event is \$200 / driver.

An **Autocross** event is a timed car-control event. You drive your vehicle through a single-lap pre-set road course defined by orange cones. Each driver will get many runs (a run is typically 1-2 minutes). This can be a week night event or a weekend day event. Cost for this event is fixed at about \$1500 so, the more participants, the cheaper per car.
